

Artemis and her twin brother Apollo were Olympian Gods, albeit illegitimate.




Ephesian Artemis

Prostitutes' House




After the Celsus Library was built, a tunnel was made from the brothel to the library. This made it easy for a man to tell his wife that he was "going to the library."


