## Week 2--Ephesus: Learning to Become Mature

## Background: Who Were the Ephesians?

The Asiarchs: They regulated the worship of Rome and of the emperor. While many presided over the public games and the religious rites in honor of the gods and the emperor, some handled the clerical work. We find the names of many Asiarchs on coins and inscriptions. The office could only be held by men of wealth, as the expenses of the provincial games were often paid for by the Asiarchs. classic.net.bible.org/dictionary.p

The Aristocrats: Not only did they live in beautiful homes near the theater, they also paid for the construction of the gymnasiums, the Odeom and other of places of public interest. They held power in the political governance of the city.

**The Slaves:** In *Rome* the slave population was around 25-40% of the population as a whole. In larger influential cities like Pergamum and Ephesus it was likely around 20-30 % of the population of the city.

The Aritisans: In the 1st Century, it was common for artisans to form guilds organized around a patron idol. Usually, these guilds had an area in the city and a hall near the market square, which functioned as a center for the guild's religious and civic activities. We know that there was a guild of silversmiths in Ephesus and that Aquila and Priscilla worked as leather workers (tentmakers) in the city.
