THE ACTS OF THE APOSTLES

Notice that the book of Acts is a continuation of the narrative begun in the book of Luke. It was written by the same writer, Luke, to the same person, Theophilus (Acts 1:1;, Luke 1:3b), who was possible a Roman official, and probably a Christian. While the gospels tell what Jesus *began* to do and teach (Acts 1:1), the book of Acts tells what Jesus *continued* to do and teach-no longer in person--but through the apostles, as they were empowered by the Holy Spirit. Read about these events below:
