How to Study a Book of the Bible

Read or listen to the book in one sitting if possible. (Revelation takes about an hour)

Print out a copy of the book. (Permission from the Lockman Foundation for this study)

I take out the verses and put each chapter onto a power point slide in order to get an OVERVIEW of all the chapters in one glance. This helps me look for shifts in topics and natural divisions.

Look for repeated words or phrases that show the emphases being taken.

- Most mentioned/Least mentioned words
- First mentions/Final mentions

Look for summary verses.

Start with what is known (like putting together the frame of the puzzle first).

Use other Scripture to shed light on the UNKNOWN.

Look up words in Bible dictionaries or Bible encyclopedias.

Draw initial conclusions in summary form.

Consult conservative commentaries and teachers.
